“Condition—

Antler removal may only be performed where the velvet is frayed and the greater part of it shed.”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Prohibited Procedures on Protected Animals (Exemptions) (Scotland) Regulations 2010 to insert conditions to be applied to two exempted procedures.

Regulation 2(2) inserts a condition specifying the length of a sheep's tail which must be retained when it is docked.

Regulation 2(3) inserts a condition relating to the requirements which must be met before a deer's antlers may be removed.

A business and regulatory impact assessment has not been produced for this instrument as it has no impact on the costs of business, charities or the voluntary sector.
