## PART 3

## Occupations

- 1. Firearms dealer.
- **2.** Any occupation in respect of which an application to the Gambling Commission for a licence, certificate or registration is required by or under any enactment.
- **3.** Any occupation which is concerned with the management of a place in respect of which the approval of the Scottish Ministers is required by section 1 of the Abortion Act 1967(1).
- **4.** Any occupation in respect of which the holder is required pursuant to regulation 4 of the Control of Explosives Regulations 1991(2) to obtain from the chief officer of police an explosives certificate certifying that person to be a fit person to acquire or acquire and keep explosives.
  - 5. Taxi driver or private hire driver.
- **6.** Any occupation in respect of which an application to the Security Industry Authority for a licence is required by the Private Security Industry Act 2001(3).
- **7.** Any occupation which is concerned with visiting persons detained in police stations, for the purposes of examining and reporting on the conditions under which they are held.
- **8.** Any occupation in respect of which a licence or registration is required by or under Part V (driving instruction) of the Road Traffic Act 1988(4).
