Modification of Acts

Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981

- **8.** In section 11A of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 (snares: training, identification numbers, tags etc.)(1)—
 - (a) in subsection (3), for the third "a" substitute "the";
 - (b) in subsection (4)—
 - (i) at the beginning, for "A" substitute "The"; and
 - (ii) in paragraph (a), omit from the second "in" to "area";
 - (c) omit subsection (7);
 - (d) in subsection (8)—
 - (i) in paragraph (b), for "a" substitute "the"; and
 - (ii) in paragraph (f), for "chief constables" substitute "the chief constable"; and
 - (e) in subsection (9)—
 - (i) for the definition of "chief constable" substitute—
 "chief constable" means the chief constable of the Police Service of Scotland; and
 - (ii) omit the definition of "chief constable's police area".
