The Social Care (Self-directed Support) (Scotland) Act 2013 (Consequential and Saving Provisions) Order 2014

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Social Care (Self-directed Support) (Scotland) Act 2013 (Consequential and Saving Provisions) Order 2014 and comes into force on 1st April 2014.

Consequential modifications

- **2.**—(1) The enactments mentioned in the first column of the table in Part 1 of the Schedule are repealed to the extent specified in the second column of that table.
- (2) The enactments mentioned in the first column of the table in Part 2 of the Schedule are revoked to the extent specified in the second column of that table.
- (3) The provisions of the enactments mentioned in the first and second columns of the table in Part 3 of the Schedule are amended to the extent specified in the third column of that table.

Saving provision

3. The modifications in article 2 of this Order do not have effect in respect of any payment made under section 12B of the Social Work (Scotland) Act 1968(1) after this Order comes into force.
