The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 24(5) of the Regulation of Investigatory Powers (Scotland) Act 2000(1) ("the Act") and all other powers enabling them to do so.

The Scottish Ministers have in accordance with:

- (1) section 24(7) of the Act prepared a draft revised code of practice relating to covert surveillance under the Act and interference with property or wireless telegraphy under Part III of the Police Act 1997(2);
- (2) section 24(3) of the Act, published that draft revised code of practice and considered any representations made to them about that draft; and
- (3) section 24(4) of the Act laid that draft revised code of practice before the Scottish Parliament. In accordance with section 24(9) of the Act, a draft of this Order has been laid before and approved by resolution of the Scottish Parliament.
