**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Asset Transfer Request (Designation of Relevant Authority) (Scotland) Order 2019 and comes in to force on 1 April 2019.

**Designation of relevant authority**

2. VisitScotland<sup>(2)</sup> is designated as a relevant authority for the purposes of Part 5 (asset transfer requests) of the Community Empowerment (Scotland) Act 2015.
