SCHEDULE 1 — Transitional and saving provisions

1. Appeals, complaints, and proceedings in progress before the Lands Tribunal immediately prior to 1 April 2023 to transfer to the Upper Tribunal
2. Decisions, directions and orders of the Lands Tribunal to continue in force
3. Time limits in respect of appeals, complaints, referrals to, and proceedings before the Lands Tribunal to carry over to the Upper Tribunal
4. Unexercised right of appeal to the Lands Valuation Appeal Court, if exercised, remains as an appeal to the Lands Valuation Appeal Court
5. Exercised right of appeal to the Lands Valuation Appeal Court
