“SCHEDULE 6A

RELIEF FOR CERTAIN ACQUISITIONS BY LOCAL AUTHORITIES

*(introduced by section 27)*

*The relief*

1. A land transaction under which the buyer is a local authority is exempt from charge if either of the qualifying conditions are met.

*The qualifying conditions*

2. The qualifying conditions are—

- (a) that the transaction is entered into in pursuance of powers conferred by section 2 of the Housing (Scotland) Act 1987<sup>(1)</sup> (powers of local authority to provide housing accommodation), or
- (b) that the transaction is funded with the assistance of a grant or other financial assistance under section 2 of the Housing (Scotland) Act 1988<sup>(2)</sup> (general functions of Scottish Homes).”
