**CONTAMINATION OF FOOD**

**The Food Protection (Emergency Prohibitions)  
(Amnesic Shellfish Poisoning) (West Coast)  
Partial Revocation (No. 2) (Scotland) Order 1999**

*Made - - - - 9th November 1999*

*Laid before the Scottish*

*Parliament - - - - 17th November 1999*

*Coming into force in accordance with article 1*

The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 1(1) and (2) and section 24(1) of the Food and Environment Protection Act 1985<sup>(1)</sup>, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Order:

(1) 1985 c. 48; section 1(1) and (2) was amended by section 51(2)(a) and (b) of the Food Safety Act 1990 (c. 16); section 1(2) defines “designating authority”; section 1(2) was further amended by the Scotland Act 1998 (Modification of Functions) Order 1999 (S.I.1999/1756). The functions of the Secretary of State were transferred to the Scottish Ministers by virtue of section 53 of the Scotland Act 1998 (c. 46).
