**The Local Government Pension Scheme
(Scotland) Amendment Regulations 2000**

First instance decisions

40. In regulation 96–

- (a) in paragraph (3), for “the employment ends” substitute “the earlier of the date the employment ends or the date specified in the notification mentioned in regulation 7(3)”;
- (b) in paragraph (9), after “independent registered medical practitioner” insert “who is qualified in occupational health medicine”;
- (c) in paragraph (10), for “that authority’s approval” substitute “the approval of the appropriate administering authority to their choice of registered medical practitioner”; and
- (d) after paragraph (13), add as a new paragraph–

“(14) In paragraph (9)–

- (a) “permanently incapable” has the meaning given by regulation 26(5); and
- (b) “qualified in occupational health medicine” means holding a diploma in occupational medicine (D Occ Med) or an equivalent qualification issued by a competent authority in a EEA State (which has the meaning given by the European Specialist Medical Qualification Order 1995⁽¹⁾), or being an Associate, a Member, or a Fellow of the Faculty of Occupational Medicine or an equivalent institution of an EEA State.”.
