The National Health Service (General Dental Services) (Scotland) Amendment (No. 3) Regulations 2000

The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 2(5), 25(1) and (2), 28A, 105(7) and 108(1) of the National Health Service (Scotland) Act 1978⁽¹⁾ and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Regulations:

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the National Health Service (General Dental Services) (Scotland) Amendment (No. 3) Regulations 2000 and shall come into force on 1st December 2000.

(2) In these Regulations, “the principal Regulations” means the National Health Service (General Dental Services) (Scotland) Regulations 1996⁽²⁾.

Amendment of regulation 23 of the principal Regulations

2.—(1) Regulation 23 of the principal Regulations (approval of payments) is amended as follows.

(2) In paragraph (4)(b) for “, VIII and XI” there is substituted “, VIII and IX”.

The functions of the Secretary of State were transferred to the Scottish Ministers by virtue of section 53 of the Scotland Act [1998 \(c. 46\)](#).
