**The Firemen's Pension Scheme (Pension
Sharing on Divorce) (Scotland) Order 2001**

Made - - - - *10th September 2001*

Laid before the Scottish

Parliament - - - - *13th September 2001*

Coming into force - - *5th October 2001*

The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 26 of the Fire Services Act 1947⁽¹⁾, section 8 of the Fire Services Act 1959⁽²⁾, sections 12 and 16 of the Superannuation Act 1972⁽³⁾ and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, and after consultation with the Scottish Central Fire Brigades Advisory Council, hereby make the following Order:
