The African Swine Fever (Scotland) Order 2003

Cleansing and disinfection

12.—(1) Disinfection under this Order shall be carried out with a disinfectant approved for the purpose under the Diseases of Animals (Approved Disinfectants) Order 1978⁽¹⁾.

(2) Acaricides used pursuant to this Order shall be ones registered under the Control of Pesticides Regulations 1986⁽²⁾ or authorised under the Biocidal Products Regulations 2001⁽³⁾.

(3) Cleansing and disinfection operations and, where appropriate, the application of an acaricide on any premises and in respect of any vehicle or other thing on those premises, or on any means of transport, shall be carried out under the supervision of a veterinary inspector or an inspector acting under the direction of a veterinary inspector.
