The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 26 of the International Criminal Court (Scotland) Act 2001(a) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the International Criminal Court (Enforcement of Fines, Forfeiture and Reparation Orders) (Scotland) (Revocation) Regulations 2004 and shall come into force on 9th October 2004.

Revocation

2. The International Criminal Court (Enforcement of Fines, Forfeiture and Reparation Orders) (Scotland) Regulations 2004(b) are hereby revoked.
