

Executive Note

The Mental Health (Care and Treatment) (Scotland) Act 2003 (Modification of Enactments) Order 2005 SSI 2005 No.465

The above Order is subject to affirmative resolution procedure. It is to be made in exercise of the powers conferred by section 330 of the Mental Health (Care and Treatment) (Scotland) Act 2003 (“the 2003 Act”).

Policy Objectives

The purpose of the Order is to modify a number of provisions in the 2003 Act and to modify other primary legislation having effect in Scotland supplementary to, incidental to or as a consequence of the 2003 Act and the repeal of the Mental Health (Scotland) Act 1984. The Order is intended to ensure that the purposes of the 2003 Act can be fully achieved, that full effect is given to the provisions of the 2003 Act, as well as ensuring account is taken of the consequences of the 2003 Act on other legislation.

Consultation

It has not been considered that any consultation is necessary.

Financial Effects

The Order has no financial effects on the Scottish Executive or any other organisation.
