The Children (Protection at Work) (Scotland) Regulations 2006

Amendments of the Act

2. In section 28(1) (restrictions on employment of children) of the Children and Young Persons (Scotland) Act 1937 ^{M1}, after paragraph (d) insert:—

“(da) for more than twelve hours in any week in which he is required to attend school; or”.
