**The Family Law (Scotland) Act 2006  
(Consequential Modifications) Order 2006**

**The Law Reform (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Scotland) Act 1968**

**3.** In section 7 of the Law Reform (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Scotland) Act 1968<sup>(1)</sup> (protection of trustees and executors)–

- (a) repeal the word “illegitimate” wherever it occurs;
- (b) in paragraphs (a) and (b) after “person” insert–  
“whose parents are not or have not been married to one another”; and
- (c) in paragraph (c)–
  - (i) after “of” insert “a”;
  - (ii) repeal the word “an” where it first occurs; and
  - (iii) after “person” insert–  
“whose parents are not or have not been married to one another”.
