**The Food (Emergency Control)  
(Scotland) Revocation Regulations 2006**

The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972<sup>(1)</sup> and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, after consultation as required by Article 9 of Regulation (EC) No. 178/2002 of the European Parliament and of the Council laying down the general principles and requirements of food law, establishing the European Food Safety Authority and laying down procedures in matters of food safety<sup>(2)</sup>, hereby make the following Regulations:

**Citation, commencement and extent**

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Food (Emergency Control) (Scotland) Revocation Regulations 2006 and come into force on 1st October 2006.

(2) These Regulations extend to Scotland only.

**Revocations**

2. The instruments specified in column 1 of the Schedule are revoked.

The functions conferred on a Minister of the Crown under section 2(2), insofar as exercisable within devolved competence, were transferred to the Scottish Ministers by virtue of section 53 of the 1998 Act.
