**The Registration of Births, Still-births, Deaths and Marriages  
(Prescription of Forms and Errors) (Scotland) Regulations 2006**

**Form etc. of abbreviated extracts of birth**

**4.** The prescribed particulars to be extracted from an entry in the register of births and contained in an abbreviated extract shall be—

- (a) the registration district(1) in which the birth was registered (and the registration district number or volume number(2) pertaining to that district);
- (b) the year in which the birth was registered;
- (c) the entry number;
- (d) surname and name;
- (e) sex of the person;
- (f) when the person was born; and
- (g) where the person was born.
