Markets

- 19.—(1) The operator of a market shall not allow an animal to enter the market unless it is accompanied by-
 - (a) an identification document;
 - (b) a cattle passport issued for that animal under Regulation (EC) No. 820/1997[F1, Regulation (EC) No 1760/2000 of the European Parliament and of the Council establishing a system for the identification and registration of bovine animals and regarding the labelling of beef and beef products and repealing Council Regulation (EC) No 820/1997 as it has effect in EU law,] or Regulation (EC) No. 1760/2000 in [F2a] member State, the Channel Islands, the Isle of Man or Northern Ireland; or
 - (c) a movement document.
 - (2) Failure to comply with this paragraph is an offence.
