The Private Security Industry Act 2001 (Commencement No. 2) (Scotland) Order 2007

The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 26(2) of the Private Security Industry Act 2001(1), and having consulted the Secretary of State in accordance with section 26(2A) (b) of that Act(2), make the following Order:
