**ROAD TRAFFIC**

The A90 Trunk Road (B957 Tannadice Junction) (Temporary Prohibition of Specified Turns) Order 2008

*Made*

*14<sup>th</sup> August 2008*

*Coming into force*

*28<sup>th</sup> August 2008*

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 14(1)(a) of that Act, they are satisfied that the traffic on the length of road specified in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order should be prohibited from making any turn specified in Part 2 of the Schedule to this Order because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the said length of road.

In accordance with section 14(3) of that Act, they are satisfied that there is an alternative route suitable for traffic which will be affected by this Order.

**Citation, commencement and cessation**

1. This Order may be cited as the A90 Trunk Road (B957 Tannadice Junction) (Temporary Prohibition of Specified Turns) Order 2008, comes into force on 28<sup>th</sup> August 2008 and ceases to have effect at midnight on 27<sup>th</sup> November 2008.

**Prohibition of use of vehicles**

2. Subject to Articles 3 and 4 of this Order, no person shall use, or permit the use of, any vehicle on the length of road specified in Part 1 of the Schedule to the Order so as to make any turn specified in Part 2 of the Schedule to this Order when such prohibition is identified as applying to any part or parts of the said length of road by means of traffic signs as prescribed by Diagrams 612 or 613 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(b).

### **Permission or direction of Police Constable**

3. No provision of this Order shall apply to anything done with the permission or upon the direction of a police constable in uniform.

### **Exemption for emergency and works vehicles**

4. No provision of this Order shall apply to a vehicle while being used in an emergency for fire brigade, coastguard, ambulance or police purposes or a vehicle being used for carrying out the works.

SCHEDULE

PART 1

That length of the M90/A90 Inverkeithing – Fraserburgh Trunk Road from a point 435 metres or thereby south of its junction with the B957 Tannadice Junction to a point 735 metres or thereby north of its junction with the B957 Tannadice Junction, a distance of 1170 metres or thereby

PART 2

1. All right turns to and from the unclassified road U370 Junction.
2. All right turns to and from the B957 Tannadice Junction.
3. All left turns to and from the B957 Tannadice Junction.
4. All left turns to and from the unclassified road U370 Junction.
5. All right turns to and from the field access directly opposite the B957 Tannadice Junction.
6. All right turns to and from the access to the Toll House 453 metres or thereby north of the B957 Tannadice Junction.
