**The Town and Country Planning (Temporary Stop Notice) (Scotland) Regulations 2009**

**Citation, commencement and interpretation**

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Town and Country Planning (Temporary Stop Notice) (Scotland) Regulations 2009 and come into force on 3rd August 2009.

(2) In these Regulations “caravan” has the same meaning as for the purposes of Part 1 of the Caravan Sites and Control of Development Act 1960(1).

**Circumstances in which temporary stop notice does not prohibit stationing of caravan**

2.—(1) The stationing of a caravan on any land in the circumstances specified in paragraph (2) is an activity prescribed for the purposes of section 144B(1)(b) of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997.

(2) The circumstances are that—

- (a) the caravan is stationed on the land immediately before the issue of the temporary stop notice;
- (b) the caravan is at that time occupied by a person as that person’s main residence.
