The Town and Country Planning (Temporary Stop Notice) (Scotland) Regulations 2009

Circumstances in which temporary stop notice does not prohibit stationing of caravan

- **2.**—(1) The stationing of a caravan on any land in the circumstances specified in paragraph (2) is an activity prescribed for the purposes of section 144B(1)(b) of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997.
 - (2) The circumstances are that-
 - (a) the caravan is stationed on the land immediately before the issue of the temporary stop notice;
 - (b) the caravan is at that time occupied by a person as that person's main residence.
