

**NOTE AS TO EARLIER COMMENCEMENT ORDERS UNDER THE  
CRIMINAL JUSTICE AND LICENSING (SCOTLAND) ACT 2010**

*(This note is not part of the Order)*

The Criminal Justice and Licensing (Scotland) Act 2010 received Royal Assent on 6th August 2010 and sections 201, 202, 204, 205 and 206 came into force on that day. The first commencement order, the Criminal Justice and Licensing (Scotland) Act 2010 (Commencement No. 1) Order 2010 ([S.S.I. 2010/297](#)) was made on 12th August 2010. The second commencement order, the Criminal Justice and Licensing (Scotland) Act 2010 (Commencement No. 2) Order 2010 ([S.S.I. 2010/339](#)) was made on 22nd September 2010. The third commencement order, the Protection of Vulnerable Groups (Scotland) Act 2007 (Commencement No. 4) and the Criminal Justice and Licensing (Scotland) Act 2010 (Commencement No. 3) Order 2010 ([S.S.I. 2010/344](#)) was made on 23rd September 2010.
