**The Adam Smith College, Fife  
(Transfer and Closure) Order 2013**

**Interpretation**

**2.** In this Order—

“the 1992 Act” means the Further and Higher Education (Scotland) Act 1992;

“Adam Smith” means the institution named The Adam Smith College, Fife being a college of further education established under section 3 of the 1992 Act<sup>(1)</sup>;

“the Adam Smith Board” means the Board of Management of The Adam Smith College, Fife established under section 3 of the 1992 Act;

“Carnegie” means the institution named Carnegie College being a college of further education prescribed under section 11(1) of the 1992 Act<sup>(2)</sup>;

“the Carnegie Board” means the Board of Management of Carnegie College established as a body corporate by section 11(2) of the 1992 Act, which is a charity entered in the Scottish Charity Register, charity number SC021182; and

“enactment” has the meaning given in schedule 1 to the Interpretation and Legislative Reform (Scotland) Act 2010<sup>(3)</sup>.

Section 3(4) of the 1992 Act was amended by section 30 of the 2005 Act.
