# The Post-16 Education (Scotland) Act 2013 (Commencement No. 4 and Transitory Provisions) Order 2014

#### Citation, commencement and interpretation

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Post-16 Education (Scotland) Act 2013 (Commencement No. 4 and Transitory Provisions) Order 2014 and comes into force on 1st May 2014.
  - (2) In this Order "the Act" means the Post-16 Education (Scotland) Act 2013.

### Appointed days

- **2.**—(1) 1st May 2014 is the day appointed for the coming into force of the provisions of the Act specified in column 1 of Schedule 1 to this Order (the subject matter of which is described in column 2 of Schedule 1), in so far as they are not already in force.
- (2) 1st August 2014 is the day appointed for the coming into force of the provisions of the Act specified in column 1 of Schedule 2 to this Order (the subject matter of which is described in column 2 of Schedule 2), in so far as they are not already in force.
- (3) Where a purpose is specified in column 3 of Schedule 1 or 2 in relation to any provision, that provision comes into force on appointed day for that purpose only.

#### Transitory modification: regional boards

- 3. Until 1st August 2014, schedule 2B to the 2005 Act (regional boards) (1) is to be read as if—
  - (a) in paragraph 3(2)(f), for "10" there were substituted "17";
  - (b) in paragraph 7(1)(b) the words "(unless holding office in pursuance of paragraph 3(2)(b))" were omitted; and
  - (c) in paragraph 9(2) the words "(except for a member appointed in pursuance of paragraph 3(2)(b))" were omitted.
