# The Town and Country Planning (Hazardous Substances Inquiry Session Procedure) (Scotland) Amendment Rules 2015

The Scottish Ministers make the following Rules in exercise of the powers conferred by section 9 of the Tribunals and Inquiries Act  $1992(\mathbf{a})$  and all other powers enabling them to do so.

#### Citation and commencement

**1.** These Rules may be cited as the Town and Country Planning (Hazardous Substances Inquiry Session Procedure) (Scotland) Amendment Rules 2015 and come into force on 14th September 2015.

# Amendment of the Town and Country Planning (Hazardous Substances Inquiry Session Procedure) (Scotland) Rules 2015

**2.**—(1) The Town and Country Planning (Hazardous Substances Inquiry Session Procedure) (Scotland) Rules 2015(**b**) are amended in accordance with paragraphs (2) and (3).

(2) In rule 4(1) (notice of inquiry session and specified matters) omit "must be given".

(3) In the Schedule (closed evidence)—

- (a) in paragraph 3, for "is restricted" substitute "are restricted"; and
- (b) in paragraph 10(1), in the definition of "appointed representative" after "(who is also a specified person)" insert "appointed".
