**The Children and Young People (Scotland) Act 2014  
(Modification of Schedules 2 and 3) Order 2016**

*Made* - - - - *15th March 2016*

*Coming into force* - - *16th March 2016*

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 31(2)(a) and 44(2)(a) of the Children and Young People (Scotland) Act 2014<sup>(a)</sup> and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 99(2) of that Act, a draft of this Order has been laid before and approved by resolution of the Scottish Parliament.

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Children and Young People (Scotland) Act 2014 (Modification of Schedules 2 and 3) Order 2016 and comes into force on the day after the day on which it is made.

**Modification of schedules 2 and 3 to the Children and Young People (Scotland) Act 2014**

2.—(1) The Children and Young People (Scotland) Act 2014 is modified as follows.

(2) In schedule 2 (relevant authorities), after paragraph 14<sup>(b)</sup> insert—

“15 The Principal Reporter.”

(3) In schedule 3 (listed authorities), after paragraph 15<sup>(c)</sup> insert—

“16 The Principal Reporter.”
