**The Rent Regulation and Assured Tenancies  
(Forms) (Scotland) Regulations 2017**

The Scottish Ministers make the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by section 53(1) and (3) and paragraph 8(1)(a) of schedule 5 of the Rent (Scotland) Act 1984<sup>(1)</sup> and sections 17(2), and (3), 19(3), 24(1) and (3), 34(1), 48(2), 53(3) and 55(1) of the Housing (Scotland) Act 1988<sup>(2)</sup> and all other powers enabling them to do so.
