The Lands Tribunal for Scotland Amendment (Fees) Rules 2017

Made - - - - 30th November 2017
Laid before the Scottish
Parliament - - - - 4th December 2017
Coming into force - - 21st December 2017

The Scottish Ministers make the following Rules in exercise of the powers conferred by section 3(6) and (12)(e) of the Lands Tribunal Act 1949⁽¹⁾ and all other powers enabling them to do so.

The requirement to obtain Treasury consent was removed by section 55 of the Scotland Act 1998 (and paragraph 106 of schedule 3A of the 2003 Act).
