**The Asset Transfer Request (Designation of Relevant Authority)  
(Scotland) Order 2019**

*Made* - - - - - *19th March 2019*

*Coming into force* - - - - - *1st April 2019*

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 78(3) of the Community Empowerment (Scotland) Act 2015<sup>(a)</sup> and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 142(2) of that Act, a draft of this instrument has been laid before and approved by resolution of the Scottish Parliament.

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Asset Transfer Request (Designation of Relevant Authority) (Scotland) Order 2019 and comes in to force on 1 April 2019.

**Designation of relevant authority**

2. VisitScotland<sup>(b)</sup> is designated as a relevant authority for the purposes of Part 5 (asset transfer requests) of the Community Empowerment (Scotland) Act 2015.

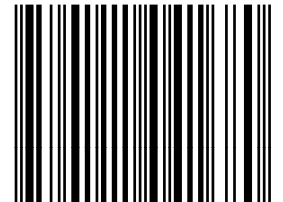
