The Public Health Scotland Order 2019

Made - - - - - *23rd October 2019*

Laid before the Scottish

Parliament - - - - - *25th October 2019*

Coming into force in accordance with article 1

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 2(1)(b), (1A), (1B), (1C) and 105(6) and (7) of the National Health Service (Scotland) Act 1978⁽¹⁾ and all other powers enabling them to do so.

The functions of the Secretary of State were transferred to the Scottish Ministers by virtue of section 53 of the Scotland Act 1998 (c.46).
