The National Bus Travel Concession Scheme for Older and Disabled Persons (Scotland) Amendment Order 2020

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 40(1), (3) and (4) and 52(4) of the Transport (Scotland) Act 2005(1) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the National Bus Travel Concession Scheme for Older and Disabled Persons (Scotland) Amendment Order 2020 and comes into force on 1 April 2020.

- **2.**—(1) The National Bus Travel Concession Scheme for Older and Disabled Persons (Scotland) Order 2006(2) is amended as follows.
 - (2) At the end of article 12(2B)(j) insert—
 - (k) for the financial year beginning on 1 April 2020 £226,100,000.".
 - (3) In article 12(2D)—
 - (a) at the end of paragraph (f) omit "and",
 - (b) at the end of paragraph (g) insert—
 - (h) 55.9% for the financial year beginning on 1 April 2020.".
