**The Agriculture (Retained EU Law and Data) (Scotland)
Act 2020 (Commencement No. 1) Regulations 2020**

The Scottish Ministers make the following Regulations in exercise of the power conferred by section 26(2) of the Agriculture (Retained EU Law and Data) (Scotland) Act 2020⁽¹⁾.

Citation and Commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Agriculture (Retained EU Law and Data) (Scotland) Act 2020 (Commencement No. 1) Regulations 2020 and come into force on 5 November 2020.

Appointed Day

2. 5 November 2020 is the day appointed for the coming into force of the following provisions of the Agriculture (Retained EU Law and Data) (Scotland) Act 2020—

- (a) section 1 (Defined terms),
- (b) section 2 (Power to simplify or improve CAP legislation),
- (c) section 3 (Power to provide for the operation of CAP legislation beyond 2020), and
- (d) section 4 (Power to modify financial provision in CAP legislation).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations bring into force sections 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the Agriculture (Retained EU Law and Data) (Scotland) Act 2020 on 5 November 2020.

The Bill for that Act received Royal Assent on 1 October 2020. Section 5 and sections 21 to 27 came into force on the day after that.
