
EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Health Protection (Coronavirus) (International Travel) (Scotland) Regulations 2020 to—

- a) remove exemptions from the requirement to complete the Passenger Locator Form for people who have arrived in Scotland from South Africa or who have arrived in Scotland from elsewhere and, during the 10 days preceding their arrival in Scotland, have been in or transited through South Africa (“South Africa arrivals”).
- b) remove exemptions from the requirement to stay in specified premises for South Africa arrivals,
- c) require people residing at the same address as South Africa arrivals to self-isolate.

An impact assessment has not been produced for this instrument.
