ROAD TRAFFIC

The A83 Trunk Road (Campbeltown) (Temporary Prohibition of Specified Turns and Temporary Prohibition on Waiting, Loading and Unloading) (No. 2) Order 2021

Made - - - - *25th June 2021*

Coming into force - - *8th July 2021*

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 2(1) and (2), 4(1) and 14(1)(a) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 14(1)(a) of that Act, they are satisfied that the traffic on the length of road specified in the schedule should be restricted or prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near that length of road.

In accordance with section 14(3) of that Act, they have had regard to the existence of alternative routes suitable for the traffic which will be affected by this Order.

Citation, commencement and cessation

1. This Order may be cited as the A83 Trunk Road (Campbeltown) (Temporary Prohibition of Specified Turns and Temporary Prohibition on Waiting, Loading and Unloading) (No. 2) Order 2021, comes into force on 8 July 2021 and ceases to have effect on 12 August 2021.

Prohibition of specified turns

2. No person may use, or permit the use of, any vehicle on the length of road specified in Part 1 of the schedule of this Order so as to make any turn specified in Part 2 of the schedule when a prohibition is identified as applying to that length of road by means of an appropriate traffic sign of the type described in item 7 (diagram 612 – no right turn for vehicular traffic) or item 8 (diagram 613 – no left turn for vehicular traffic) of the sign table in Part 2 of schedule 3 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016(b).

The Scottish Ministers are the traffic authority by virtue of section 121A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (inserted by the 1991 Act, schedule 8, paragraph 70 and amended by S.I. 2001/1400) as read with section 151(1) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 (c.54) (relevantly amended by S.I. 2001/1400). The functions of the Secretary of State were transferred to the Scottish Ministers by section 53 of the Scotland Act 1998 (c.46).

Prohibition on waiting, loading and unloading

3. No person may use, or permit the use of, any vehicle to wait, load or unload on the length of road, or a part or parts of the length of road specified in Part 1 of the schedule of this Order when a prohibition is identified as applying to that length of road, or a part or parts of that length of road, by means of one or both of the traffic signs of the type described in item 19 (diagram 636 – temporary prohibition of waiting except for loading and unloading) and item 20 (diagram 636.1 – temporary prohibition of loading and unloading) of the sign table in Part 6 of schedule 13 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016(a).

Exemptions

4. No prohibition imposed by this Order applies to—
- (a) a vehicle while being used in an emergency for fire brigade, ambulance, police or coastguard purposes, or
 - (b) a vehicle being used for carrying out the works.

SCHEDULE

Articles 2 and 3

PART 1

SPECIFIED LENGTH OF ROAD

That length of the A83 Tarbet – Lochgilphead – Campbeltown Trunk Road from Old Quay Roundabout, Campbeltown in a south easterly direction along Hall Street, Campbeltown to its junction with New Quay Roundabout, Campbeltown and thereafter from said junction in a north westerly direction along Hall Street, Campbeltown to its junction with Old Quay Roundabout, Campbeltown a distance of 495 metres or thereby.

PART 2

SPECIFIED TURNS

1. All right turns from St John Street, Campbeltown to Hall Street, Campbeltown.
2. All left turns from St John Street, Campbeltown to Hall Street, Campbeltown.
3. All right turns from Hall Street, Campbeltown to St John Street, Campbeltown.
4. All left turns from Hall Street, Campbeltown to St John Street, Campbeltown.
