The Town and Country Planning (General  
Permitted Development) (Coronavirus)  
(Scotland) Amendment Order 2021

*Made* - - - - 19th January 2021  
*Laid before the Scottish  
Parliament* - - - - 21st January 2021  
*Coming into force* - - 28th February 2021

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 30, 31 and 275 of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997(1) and sections 98 and 122(3) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004(2) and all other powers enabling them to do so.
