## The Social Security (Residence Requirements) (Afghanistan) (Scotland) Regulations 2021

## Amendment of the Carer's Assistance (Young Carer Grants) (Scotland) Regulations 2019

- **5.**—(1) Regulation 8 of the Carer's Assistance (Young Carer Grants) (Scotland) Regulations 2019(1) is amended in accordance with paragraphs (2) and (3).
  - (2) After regulation 8(2)(a) insert—
    - "(aa) a person who—
      - (i) has leave to enter or remain in the United Kingdom granted under the immigration rules made under section 3(2) of the Immigration Act 1971(2), by virtue of—
        - (ia) the Afghan Relocations and Assistance Policy, or
        - (ib) previous scheme for locally-employed staff in Afghanistan (sometimes referred to as the ex-gratia scheme),
      - (ii) has been granted discretionary leave outside the immigration rules as a dependant of a person referred to in sub-head (i), or
      - (iii) has leave granted under the Afghan Citizens Resettlement Scheme.".
  - (3) In paragraph (10)(3), before the definition of "EEA State", insert—
    - "the Afghan Citizens Resettlement Scheme" means the scheme announced by the United Kingdom Government on 18 August 2021(4)."
