**The Social Security (Residence Requirements)  
(Afghanistan) (Scotland) Regulations 2021**

**Amendment of the Carer’s Assistance (Young Carer Grants) (Scotland) Regulations 2019**

**5.—(1)** Regulation 8 of the Carer’s Assistance (Young Carer Grants) (Scotland) Regulations 2019<sup>(1)</sup> is amended in accordance with paragraphs (2) and (3).

(2) After regulation 8(2)(a) insert—

“(aa) a person who—

(i) has leave to enter or remain in the United Kingdom granted under the immigration rules made under section 3(2) of the Immigration Act 1971<sup>(2)</sup>, by virtue of—

(ia) the Afghan Relocations and Assistance Policy, or

(ib) previous scheme for locally-employed staff in Afghanistan (sometimes referred to as the ex-gratia scheme),

(ii) has been granted discretionary leave outside the immigration rules as a dependant of a person referred to in sub-head (i), or

(iii) has leave granted under the Afghan Citizens Resettlement Scheme.”.

(3) In paragraph (10)<sup>(3)</sup>, before the definition of “EEA State”, insert—

““the Afghan Citizens Resettlement Scheme” means the scheme announced by the United Kingdom Government on 18 August 2021<sup>(4)</sup>.”.
