Citation and commencement, etc.

- 1.—(1) This Act of Sederunt may be cited as the Act of Sederunt (Simple Procedure Amendment) (Miscellaneous) (No. 2) 2022.
 - (2) It comes into force on 11th November 2022.
 - (3) A certified copy is to be inserted in the Books of Sederunt.
