**The Animal By-Products and Animal Health
(Miscellaneous Fees) (Scotland) Regulations 2023**

Animal by-products and derived products: fees

4.—(1) This regulation and schedule 1 set out fees payable to the Scottish Ministers on demand for activities conducted by the Scottish Ministers for the purposes of the Control Regulation.

(2) In schedule 1—

- (a) the fees payable by an operator of an establishment or plant in relation to an activity specified in column 1 of Table 1 are specified in the corresponding entries in columns 2, 3 and 4 of that Table, and
- (b) the fees payable in respect of official controls, by an operator of an establishment or plant in relation to an activity specified in column 1 of Table 2 are specified in the corresponding entries in columns 2, 3 and 4 of that Table.

(3) In this regulation and schedule 1—

- (a) “the Control Regulation” means Regulation (EC) 1069/2009 of the European Parliament and of the Council laying down health rules as regards animal by-products and derived products not intended for human consumption⁽¹⁾,
- (b) words and expressions defined in Article 3 (definitions) of the Control Regulation have the same meaning as they have in the Control Regulation.

(4) In schedule 1—

- (a) “approval” includes a conditional approval under Article 44(2) (procedure for approval) of the Control Regulation,
- (b) words and expressions defined in Article 2 (definitions) of, and Annex 1 (definitions as referred to in Article 2) to, the Implementing Regulation⁽²⁾ have the same meaning as they have in the Implementing Regulation.
