## The Hate Crime and Public Order (Scotland) Act 2021 (Commencement and Transitional Provision) Regulations 2024

## Citation, commencement and interpretation

- 1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Hate Crime and Public Order (Scotland) Act 2021 (Commencement and Transitional Provision) Regulations 2024 and come into force on 1 April 2024.
  - (2) In these Regulations—
    - "existing law" means each of the 1986 Act, the 1995 Act, the 1998 Act, the 2003 Act and the 2009 Act,
    - "the 1986 Act" means the Public Order Act 1986(1),
    - "the 1995 Act" means the Criminal Law (Consolidation) (Scotland) Act 1995(2),
    - "the 1998 Act" means the Crime and Disorder Act 1998(3),
    - "the 2003 Act" means the Criminal Justice (Scotland) Act 2003(4),
    - "the 2009 Act" means the Offences (Aggravation by Prejudice) (Scotland) Act 2009(5),
    - "the 2021 Act" means the Hate Crime and Public Order (Scotland) Act 2021.
