



Diocese in Europe Measure 1980

1 Provision by Canon for representation of diocese in Convocation of Canterbury.

At any time after the diocese incorporating the former diocese of Gibraltar and the areas of Northern and Central Europe formerly within the ecclesiastical jurisdiction of the Bishop of London, and to be cited as the diocese in Europe (hereafter in this Measure referred to as “the Diocese”), is established it shall be lawful for the General Synod to submit for Her Majesty’s Licence and Assent a Canon in the form set out in Schedule 1 to this Measure which, for the purpose of making provision for the Diocese to be represented in the Convocation of Canterbury and, accordingly, in the House of Bishops and the House of Clergy of the General Synod, amends the Canons concerning the constitution of the Upper House of the said Convocation and the representation of the clergy in the Lower House thereof, and, if Her Majesty is pleased to grant Her Licence and Assent it shall be lawful for the General Synod to make, promulge and execute the said Canon.
