SCHEDULE 1

RATES OF PENSION UNDER SECTION 1 OF CLERGY PENSIONS MEASURE 1961

PART I

RATE WHERE SCHEME MEMBER RETIRES AT OR ABOVE THE RETIRING AGE

- 3 Where the qualifying period of pensionable service performed by a scheme member is less than 37 years, the rate of pension in respect of the whole-time service shall be calculated by adding together for each complete year of pensionable whole-time service $\frac{1}{37}$ th of the pension to which he would have been entitled under the foregoing provisions of this Schedule if he had performed 37 years' whole-time pensionable service; and where the whole-time pensionable service comprises a broken part of a year the rate shall be increased by adding, in respect of each complete month in the broken part, $\frac{1}{12}$ th of the amount payable in respect of a complete year.
