2 Application of other enactments containing general rules of construction.

Where by any enactment (other than the ^{M1}Interpretation Act 1889) a meaning is assigned (unless the contrary intention appears) to any word or expression in all cases where that word or expression is used in Acts of Parliament, or in Acts of Parliament passed after a certain date, that enactment shall apply to this Measure and to all Measures passed by the Church Assembly after this Measure in like manner as it applies to an Act of Parliament, and as if this Measure and those Measures were Acts of Parliament:

Provided that in all such Measures, unless the contrary intention appears—

- (a) The expression “England” shall include the town of Berwick-upon-Tweed, but shall not include any part of England or Wales to which the ^{M2}Welsh Church Act 1914 applies; and
- (b) Notwithstanding anything in such last-mentioned Act, the expression “Church of England” shall not include the Church in Wales.
