CHAPTER 2

SANCTIONS

When reduction to have effect

Suspension of a reduction where fraud penalty applies

108.—(1) A reduction in the amount of an award under section 26 or 27 of the Act is to be suspended for any period during which the provisions of section 6B, 7 or 9 of the Social Security Fraud Act 2001⁽¹⁾ apply to the award.

(2) The reduction ceases to have effect on the day on which that period begins and begins again on the day after that period ends.
