

Amendment of the Department for Transport (Driver Licensing and Vehicle Registration Fees) Order 2003

3.—(1) The Department for Transport (Driver Licensing and Vehicle Registration Fees) Order 2003(a) is amended as follows.

(2) In article 2(3)(h), for “the European Union or any other” substitute “any”.

Amendment of the Department for Transport (Fees) Order 2009

4.—(1) The Department for Transport (Fees) Order 2009(b) is amended as follows.

(2) In Schedule 1 (specified functions)—

(a) for paragraph 8 substitute—

“**8.** The functions of the Secretary of State, or traffic commissioners, in relation to the licensing of operators of public service vehicles under any retained EU law(c).”;

(b) for paragraph 45 substitute—

“**45.** The functions of the Secretary of State, or traffic commissioners, in relation to the licensing of operators of goods vehicles under any retained EU law.”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations are made in exercise of the powers in section 8 of the European Union (Withdrawal) Act 2018 (c. 16) in order to address deficiencies in retained EU law arising from the withdrawal of the United Kingdom from the European Union.

These Regulations make amendments to various Fees Orders in the field of road traffic in order to remove or replace EU references which are no longer appropriate. Regulation 2 makes amendments to the Department of Transport (Fees) Order 1988, regulation 3 makes amendments to the Department for Transport (Fees) Order 2003, and regulation 4 makes amendments to the Department for Transport (Fees) Order 2009.

An impact assessment has not been produced for this instrument as no impact on the private or voluntary sector is foreseen.

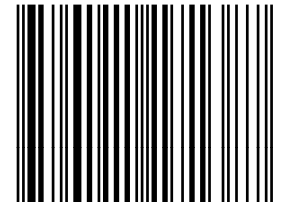
