#### CHAPTER 1

Introductory

## **Interpretation of Part 2: general**

- 2. In this Part—
  - "the 2016 Regulations" means the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2016(1);
  - "the Batteries Directive" means Directive 2006/66/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council on batteries and accumulators and waste batteries and accumulators (2);
  - "the End-of-Life Vehicles Directive" means Directive 2000/53/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council on end-of life vehicles(3);
  - "the Landfill Directive" means Council Directive 1999/31/EC on the landfill of waste(4);
  - "the Mining Waste Directive" means Directive 2006/21/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council on the management of waste from extractive industries(5);
  - "the Waste Framework Directive" means Directive 2008/98/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council on waste(6);
  - "the WEEE Directive" means Directive 2012/19/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council on waste electrical and electronic equipment (WEEE)(7).

## Meaning of appropriate authority

- **3.**—(1) In this Part, "appropriate authority" has the meaning given by this regulation.
- (2) The "appropriate authority" is—
  - (a) for regulations applying in relation to England, the Secretary of State;
  - (b) for regulations applying in relation to Wales, the Welsh Ministers;
  - (c) for regulations applying in relation to Scotland, the Scottish Ministers;

- (d) for regulations applying in relation to Northern Ireland, the Department of Agriculture, Environment and Rural Affairs.
- (3) But the appropriate authority is the Secretary of State if consent is given by—
  - (a) the Welsh Ministers for regulations applying in relation to Wales;
  - (b) the Scottish Ministers for regulations applying in relation to Scotland;
  - (c) the Department of Agriculture, Environment and Rural Affairs for regulations applying in relation to Northern Ireland.

## Meaning of "appropriate agency"

- 4. In this Part, "appropriate agency" means—
  - (a) for regulations applying in relation to England, the Environment Agency;
  - (b) for regulations applying in relation to Wales, the Natural Resources Body for Wales;
  - (c) for regulations applying in relation to Scotland, the Scottish Environment Protection Agency.
