1965 CHAPTER XV

An Act to confirm a Provisional Order of the Secretary of State relating to the borough of Llanelly.

[5th August 1965]

WHEREAS under the provisions of the Public Health Act 1875 c. 55. 1875 and the Public Health Act 1936 the Secretary of 1936 c. 49. State has made a Provisional Order which needs confirmation by Parliament:

Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The order of the Secretary of State which is set out in the Confirmation schedule to this Act is hereby confirmed and shall have full of order in validity and force. schedule.

2. This Act may be cited as the Welsh Office Provisional Short title. Order Confirmation (Llanelly) Act 1965.

BOROUGH OF LLANELLY

PROVISIONAL ORDER PARTIALLY REPEALING A LOCAL ACT

1875 c. 55.
 1936 c. 49.

The Secretary of State, on the application of the council of the borough of Llanelly and in exercise of his powers under section 303 of the Public Health Act 1875, section 317 of the Public Health Act 1936 and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

Citation and commencement.

1. This order may be cited as the Llanelly Order 1965 and shall come into operation on the date of the Act of Parliament confirming it.

Partial repeal of local Act.
 1888 c. clxxv.

2. As from the date of coming into operation of this order, section 17 of the Llanelly Local Board Act 1888 (which prohibits the erection of buildings over the River Lledi) shall be repealed.
